

Cowwarr Spectator Point

The drivers send it west on Stoney Creek Road before tossing their cars left through the fast entry, then right at the sharp triangulation in the road. Then they power out through a sweeping left and up the hill, creating great action for fans at any part of the spectator area, even more spectacular this year on Saturday night!

Features The Middle of Everywhere spectator lounge, Heyfield Pizza and El Cappuchino will be serving food, drinks. coffee and small items.

Glenmaggie Spectator Point

This daytime only spectator point offers an immersive, technically focused thrill. A short walk rewards you with close views of drivers mastering the tight corner against a stunning forest backdrop.

On-site amenities include food trucks and toilets, ensuring a comfortable experience. Ideal for families and fans.





Galvaniize Rally Central

This is the vibrant heart of the rally, located at Gordon Street Recreation Reserve in Heyfield, operating over the weekend. Entry is FREE. Teams frantically work on their cars between stages in minimal time, offering a rare, behind-the-scenes look at rally mechanics and strategy. Beyond the service park, enjoy food vendors, official event merchandise, car displays, and the latest event updates. It's an essential meeting point and a crucial part of the rally experience.

Enter only from Tyson Road at Angle Channel Road, not from Tinamba-Seaton Road!

















DO'S AND DON'TS OF SPECTATING

- Cars in competition conditions can lose control and leave the defined road at any time. Do
 not stand in any areas which are not authorised, or which are contrary to the advice of the
 organisers and officials/marshals.
- Be prepared. Weather wise, bring hats, ground cover, sun screen and protection in case of rain or cold weather. Food and drink outlets may be provided at the Public View Point (refer to public instructions), but if not, ensure you have some of your own food and drinks available.
- 3. Park your car sensibly so that it will not obstruct emergency vehicles, competitors, service crews or other members of the public. In all cases obey parking instructions given by supervising officials. It is usually best to park your car facing the way out.
- 4. Do not try to emulate drivers. Remember that if you give cause for complaint it will reflect badly on the event and the sport as a whole. Drive carefully both to and from Public Viewing Areas and be ready to give way if necessary, on narrow stretches of road.
- 5. Strictly NO DOGS at the Public Viewing Points.
- 6. Please ensure young children are completely under your control and please make sure that children do not get in the way of competing cars or mechanics or officials when they are working.
- 7. Do not light fires (unless otherwise permitted to do so in a safe environment) or smoke in the Public View Points. Do not smoke near a car that is being serviced or refuelled.
- 8. At all times keep clear of controls, including from the timing marker to the control area. If control officials ask you to move, please help them by doing so remember they have a job to do which can be difficult enough as it is. If you do want to see a control point in action, remember to stand well back from the control area.
- 9. Take your entire litter home with you it is handy to have a bag or carton in your boot. Litter left at Public View Points reflects badly on the event.
- 10. At service points do not crowd mechanics when they are working. They would not appreciate it. Neither will you if someone drops a wheel or a sump guard on your foot!
